CONSULTANCY TO DEVELOP INFORMATION TECNOLOGY STRATEGY AND ACTION PLAN





Title: Information Technology Strategy and Action Plan

1. Background

The ECOWAS Centre for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency (ECREEE), was established in 2009 in response to the energy crisis in the ECOWAS region. The Centre was officially inaugurated on the 6th of July 2010 in Praia Cape Verde, with support of the Governments of Austria, Cape Verde and Spain, and the technical assistance of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO). The overall objective of Centre is to contribute to the sustainable economic, social, and environmental development of West Africa by improving access to modern, reliable and affordable energy services, energy security and reduction of energy related GHG emissions and climate change impacts on the energy systems.

In pursuit of its mandate, ECREEE have acquired various Information and Communication systems and services, to effectively support its business operations. With the growth of its workforce and business opportunity, there is need to continually improve its operations through effective use Information Technology (IT). As a result, ECREEE resolved to improve IT governance and Operations through strategic planning, to align its actions and strategies with the business objectives. Part of its first action was the establishment an IT Steering Committee, to provide oversight on the operations, strategy, and investment in IT.

Considering the recently concluded Strategic Plan for 2023 – 2027 which is expected to drive the Institution's interventions and activities in the next five years, ECREEE intends to engage a consultant to prepare an IT strategy and action plan for the same period.

2. Objectives

The objective of the consultancy is to develop an Information Technology Strategy and Action Plan for the period 2023-2027. This will align the Information Technology actions and strategies with the overall goals and objectives of ECREEE.

3. Scope of Work

The work will cover a complete assessment of ECREEE's strategic objectives, its implications for IT and the current state of the ICT systems. The work will be divided into three phases as given below which can be revised or modified with justifications.

g)	Identify capacity building needs of ECREEE staff		
h)	conduct a SWOT analysis to identify Strengths,

- ✓ Over (5) years of experience in IT governance, development of IT strategic plans, master plans, IT processes or project management etc.



- ✓ Proven Experience implementing similar projects.
- ✓ Excellent experience in IT Services and Operations, Standards, Applications and Systems review.
- ✓ Ability to communicate and write effectively in English and/or French with good working knowledge of the other language. Fluency in Portuguese will be considered an advantage.

Preferred requirements

- ✓ Relevant certifications as a Cobit5, CGEIT, ISO, ITIL® Expert, PMP, CBPP® etc.
- ✓ Demonstrated experience working with government, regional or international organizations.
- ✓ Working experience in the ECOWAS region.
- ✓ Experience in the energy sector.

Applicants should submit the following in English, French or Portuguese.

- i. A technical proposal that includes Consultants experience, qualifications/certificates, the methodology to carry out the assignment and detailed implementation schedule.
- ii. Financial proposal in US\$ including all costs and taxes (i.e., a detailed work-time-expert-diagram indicating daily rates for individual team members).
